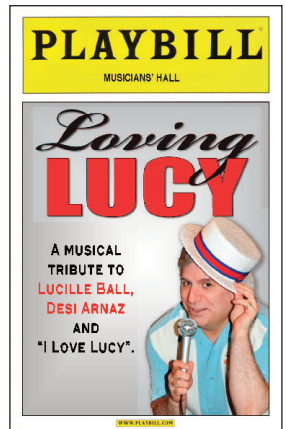
IN BRIEF:

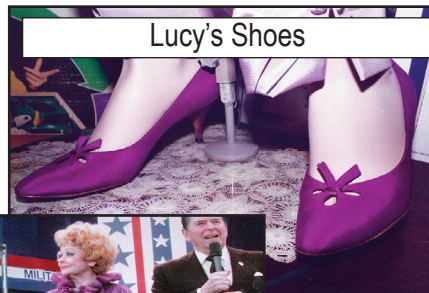

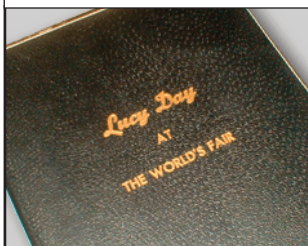

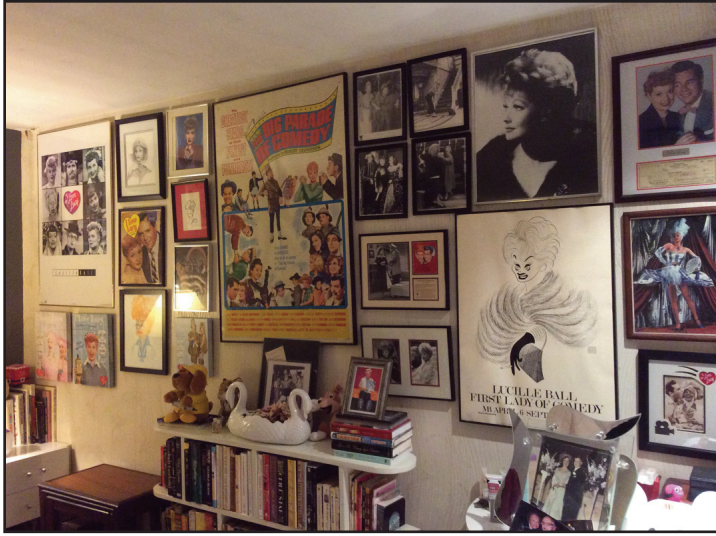

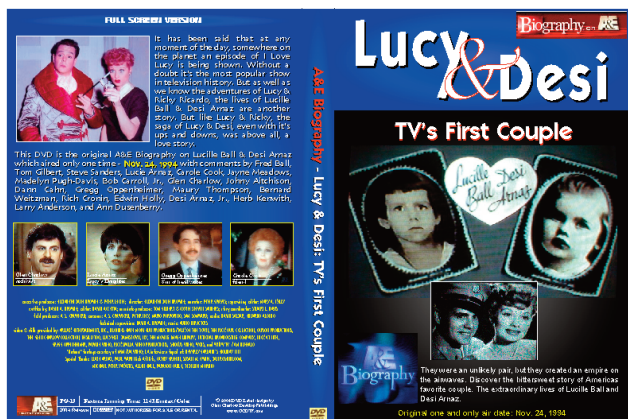

Believed to have the largest collection on the East Coast.

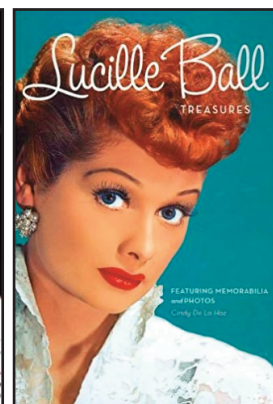

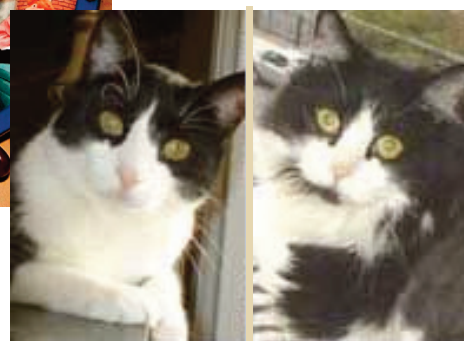

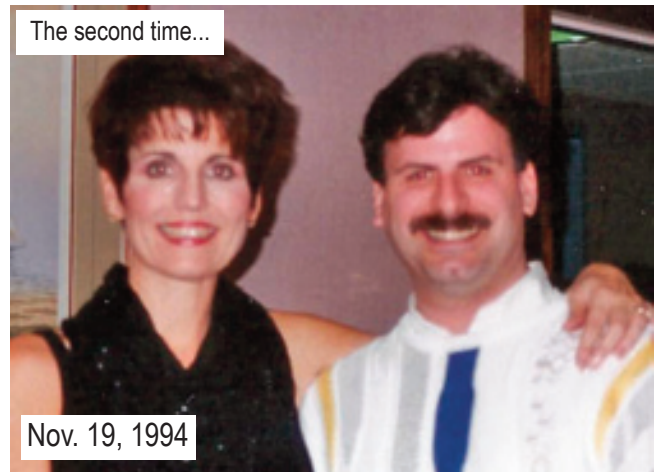
